1. SAFETY

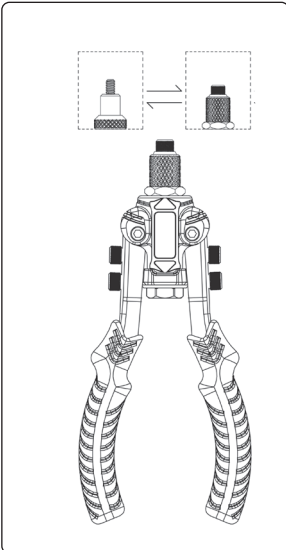
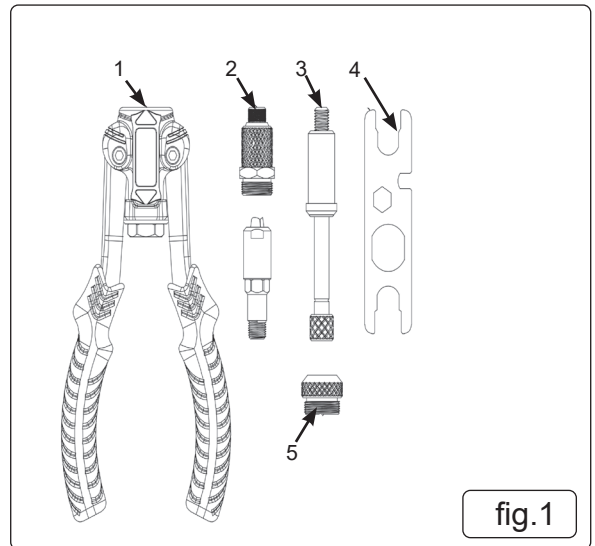

4. OPERATION

4.1. RIVETING

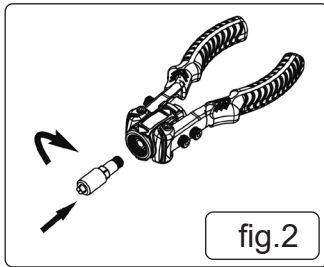

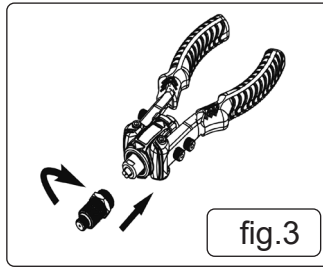

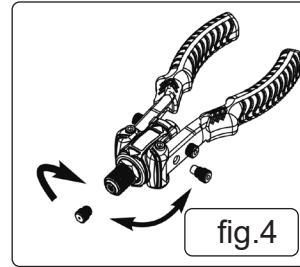

- 4.1.1. Screw rivet assembly rod (fig.1.2) into the handle.(fig.2).
- 4.1.2. Screw rivet sleeve piece (fig.1.2) into the rod (fig.3).
- 4.1.3. Place correct size nose piece into unit (fig.4).
- 4.1.4. Drill a hole suitable for the specifications of the rivet on the two pieces of material to be riveted.
- 4.1.5. Insert a rivet gun fitted with rivets of appropriate specifications into the drilled hole.
- 4.1.6. Close the handle to fix the rivet in place, then withdraw the tool.

4.2. NUT RIVETING

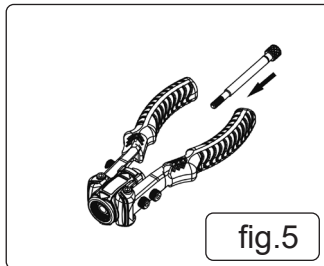

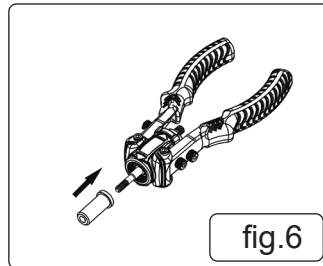

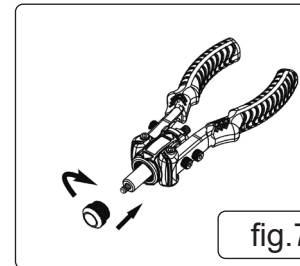

- 4.2.1. Fit nut rivet rod (fig.1.3) into the handle (fig.5).
- 4.2.2. Insert the nut rivet sleeve (fig.1.3) into the body (fig.6).
- 4.2.3. Screw the sleeve fixing nut (fig.1.5) into the unit (fig.7).
- 4.2.4. Screw in the appropriate nut rivet.
- 4.2.5. Put nut rivet into the prepared hole and rive the nut rivet into place.
- 4.2.6. After riveting completed withdraw the tool.
