2. INTRODUCTION



4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1. Place the cart bed upside down on the ground.
- 4.2. Attach two rigid casters and two swivel casters on the cart bed and tighten using M8x16 bolt, washer, and lock nut.
- 4.3. Turn the cart bed over to its normal position.
- 4.4. Insert the frame on the cart bed and tighten using M8x35 bolt, washer, and lock nut.
